

Photography and Videography

Your photographer must be informed of the following guidelines.

1. Pictures may be taken in the church up to 60 minutes prior to the ceremony: pictures of the groom, groom's family, best man, and groomsmen, bride, bridesmaids, etc..
2. Flash photography may not be taken during the service. The photographer should not roam throughout the church and is not permitted in the sanctuary during the liturgy. The photographer may go into the side chapel (Mart's Chapel if you choose to bring flowers to Mary). An ideal place from which to take photos during the liturgy is the choir loft; however, care should be taken to not interfere with the musicians.
3. Videography is permitted during the service. The videographer should not roam throughout the church.
4. Flash pictures are permitted as the wedding party leaves the Church and after the ceremony.
5. When pictures are taken after the service, photography is limited to 30 minutes immediately following the service; there may be a wedding following yours, so please be considerate.
