#### PARENT AND COACH COVENANT

I will be knowledgeable in the rules of the sport that I coach, and I will attempt to teach these rules to my players.

I will treat players, fans, officials, parents, and coaches with respect, regardless of religion, race, gender, creed, or ability. I will hold my players accountable for exhibiting the same respect.

I will lead by example, demonstrating Christian love, fair play, and sportsmanship towards all players, fans, officials, parents, and coaches. I will only address players, fans, officials, parents and coaches in a positive and

encouraging manner.

I have read the above Parent and Coach Code of Ethics and agree to abide by them, as well as the rules, regulations, guidelines, interpretations, and rulings of the WHCSA. I understand that any violation of these is

subject to review by the WHCSA, St. Theresa Catholic Church/School, and St. Theresa Memorial Youth Sports League committee and staff, and that my participation as a coach or spectator may be revoked at any time if a

violation occurs. I agree to share the above information with any and all persons who will be in attendance at my child's practices/sporting events during the course of the season. I understand that they will be subject to the same ethics agreement and consequences as outlined above.
